

10,000 Steps Community Grant Outcomes



Australian Catholic University

Grant Objectives:

- To install durable signage for the Flourish Gardens Walk, which seeks to attract local and neighbouring communities to foster a broader social engagement.
- To promote community walking groups to use the ACU Banyo campus as a health resource.

Grant Outcomes:

- 16 directional signs and 6 map signs were installed on 6 walks on the ACU Campus.
- A brochure was created which identifies off-leash dog areas to promote and support dog walking in the community.
- 48 community members registered online for walking groups, which occur on Tuesday and Thursday mornings and leave from the ACU Health Clinic.
- 25 adults participated in a guided walk.
- 10 children joined walks with their mums.
